

I-9402 Addressable Base Mount Sounder

Features

- Electronically addressed. The address can be modified in field.
- Built-in microprocessor processes information intelligently.
- Four working modes (Mode I, II, III, IV) with different addresses.

Description

I-9402 Addressable Base Mount Sounder (the sounder) is an audible signal appliance mounted in field. When there is a fire, it will give audible alarm signal to warn people in field.

Built in microprocessor, the sounder can communicate with fire alarm control panel (FACP). The microprocessor will make the buzzer sound according to different working modes when the sounder receives start command from FACP.

Connection and Cabling

Fig. 1 shows terminals of the sounder.



Z1(1), Z2(3): Signal loop of FACP, polarity-insensitive.

Recommended Cabling

1.0mm² or above fire cable, subject to local codes.


Installation

Warning: Before installing the sounder, disconnect the power from loop and verify that all the bases are securely fixed and that the wiring is correct on each base.

- 1 Before installation, check the enclosure and labels. It should be without scratch and distortion.
- 2 Mounting of the sounder is shown in Fig. 2.
- 3 Fix the Souder into back box with screws.



4 Align the orientation mark of the top cover to mark A (refer to Fig.1), rotate the sounder to align the mark with mark B, the top cover is installed. If it's used as detector base, take down the top cover and install the detector on it in the same method as mounting the top cover.



Application

The sounder can also be used as detector base to install different intelligent heat and smoke detectors to combine detection and alarm. It can be connected to the loop of fire alarm control panel without separate power supply.

Programming:

P-9910B programmer can be used to program in field. Connect the programmer with 1 and 3 terminal of the sounder. On power-on state, input the address code of the sounder (1~242), press *Program*. If programming is successful, "P" will be displayed. If it is error, "E" will be displayed. Press *Clear* to return the power-on state. It's only needed to program low address (pre-alarm sound) when the sounder occupies two consecutive address points, automatically increasing one to be high address (fire alarm). Refer to *P-9910B Hand Held Programmer Installation and Operation Manual* for details.

Setting Working Mode

On power-on state of the programmer, press *Function* and enter number 4, "—" will show on the last digit. Input the working mode parameter, press *Program,* "P" will show on the screen, meaning the corresponding mode has been set. Press *Clear* to remove, input 789 to lock, then press *Clear* to return. The sounder is defaulted as Mode III (102, or any number from 1~240 except 100, 101, 103). Mode I (100), Mode II (101), Mode IV (103) can be set in field, Programming the sounder before installation, adopts the proper mode by the actual circumstance.

Application

- ♦ The sounder can be used as detector base to mount intelligent detectors, which can both detect fire and give audible alarm signal to realize combined function. In this case, you should remove the top cover and mount the intelligent detector.
- ♦ The sounder can be directly connected into fire alarm system. When there is fire alarm message, it will activate the sounder and give fire alarm sound by pre-set cause and effect formula. System composition is shown in Fig. 3.



- A loop can connect up to 40 sounders for the heavy current when activated.
- Adopt special top cover if not connected with fire detector.
- Don't repair by yourself if there is trouble, but contact with dealer in time.
